Treasurer Report:

Anna Regi detailed income and expenses.

Cookie Dough Fundraiser:

The sale starts Thursday Jan. 5 and ends in 2 weeks. We would like to have full participation from the students. To ensure this we are creating our own prize program. There will be cash prizes for the top sellers. There is a minimum sale to qualify for a prize. The band will receive \$7.00 in profit from each tub sold. Mr. Price would like to use any profits to buy either a new saxophone, new music stands or new chairs.
